Das, Director, NIHFW; Ms. Gayatri Mishra, Joint Secretary; Prof. Mihir Kumar Mallick, Nodal Officer, CHS Cell; Mr. Anil Kumar, DDA; and Dr. Dinesh Paul, Consultant, CHS Cell; also visited the President's House along with the participants. Shri Ram Nath Kovind appreciated the role played by the doctors and health practitioners in keeping the nation healthy. He suggested that preventive approach to health rather than a curative care be employed wherever possible. He also emphasized on integrating the Indian traditional systems of medicine – AYUSH with our healthcare framework.

National Cold Chain and Vaccine Management Resource Centre

- A training on Vaccine and Cold Chain Management (T-VaCC) for Immunization Programme Managers was conducted from 30 July to 03 August, 2018 in which 14 District Immunization Officers from 5 states (Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Punjab, Rajasthan and Uttarakhand) participated.
- Three trainings of Cold Chain Technicians on Repair and Maintenance of ILR-DF and VS for Cold Chain Technicians were conducted during 11-19 July, 1-9 August and 12-20 September 2018. A total of 62 Cold Chain Technician from 10 states (Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Bihar, Punjab, Arunachal Pradesh, Goa, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Odisha and Tripura) were trained.
- A training for capacity building of Government Medical Store Depot Officials for Vaccine and Cold Chain Management in Kolkata, West Bengal, was conducted during 18-20 July 2018.

National Health Mission/RCH-II

- Quarterly Progress Report for the first Quarter (April–June 2018) was prepared and submitted to the MoHFW.
- Eight monitoring visits were conducted during July–August 2018 to monitor the quality of the ongoing trainings. The trainings were on RTI/STI, Postpartum Intrauterine Contraceptive Device (PPIUCD), Skilled Birth Attendant (SBA), Contraceptive Update, Skill Lab and Mothers' Absolute Affection (MAA) in the states of Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Jharkhand, Haryana, Punjab and Delhi.
- During this quarter, 20 health facilities (DH, UPHC, CHC, Block PHC and Sub-Centre) were also visited to assess the infrastructure and gap analysis in the States.
- Feedback along with recommendations were prepared for the state of Himachal Pradesh to improve the quality of trainings.

Centre for Health Informatics (CHI) of National Health Portal (NHP)

New Additions in the NHP



- Information related to the new diseases like Mastitis, Silicosis, Orbital Lymphangioma, Sub-conjunctival Haemorrhage, Anaemia during pregnancy have been added under the Diseases A-Z section.
- Exposure to pesticides during pregnancy is added in Pregnancy Section.
- Recently launched National Viral Hepatitis Control Programme has been added under the National Health Programmes.
- Effect of Flood and its Risk Management Impact on Health is added under the Professional Enhancement.
- CHI has revised the contents of 11 Health Days/weeks/months viz. World Population Day, World Hepatitis Day, World Breastfeeding Week, World Mosquito Day, Rastriya Poshan Maah, Spinal Cord Injury Day, World Suicide Prevention Day, World Pharmacist Day, World Rabies Day, World Heart Day and International Day of sign languages in the Health Wellness Calendar of NHP according to the selected themes.
- NHP, in its existing module of Tuberculosis, incorporated a new content for the management and prevention, developed according to the National Strategic Plan for Elimination of TB, 2017-2025 by Revised National Tuberculosis Control Programme (RNTCP) in its National Health Programme Section.
- To highlight the MoHFW's initiative of Ayushman Bharat, a two-page advertorial titled Ayushman Bharat: Providing Affordable Healthcare and one-page advertisement in Hindi and English were developed and published in the September issues of magazines- The DIALogue and EXOTICA respectively.
- NHP has made a remarkable social media presence with an approximately 22 lakhs of twitter impression and approximately 38 lakhs of facebook posts during this quarter.
