स्वास्थ्य सूचना विज्ञान केंद्र (सीएचआई) ने तीन स्वास्थ्य दिवसों, अंतरराष्ट्रीय वृद्ध दिवस विश्व मानसिक स्वास्थ्य दिवस एवं विश्व खाद्य दिवस के लिए नई विषय वस्तु को राष्ट्रीय स्वास्थ्य पोर्टल (एनएचपी) के स्वास्थ्य कैलेंडर में जोड़ा।

प्रतिवेदित अवधि में, आर.सी.एच.-दो के अंतर्गत विभिन्न स्वास्थ्य व्यावसायिकों के लिए जारी एसबीए और कौशल प्रयोगशाला प्रशिक्षण शिक्षकों की गुणवत्ता के आकलन के लिए महाराष्ट्र और तमिलनाडु में अनुवीक्षण दौरे किए गए।

National Cold-Chain and Vaccine Management Resource Centre

NCCVMRC has been conducting various activities of cold-chain and vaccine management. In the reported quarter, the centre provided technical support to Odisha for conducting Effective Vaccine Management (EVM) assessment. Odisha conducted its state EVM assessment from 25 October to 03 November 2018 in Bhubaneswar. NCCVMRC, NIHFW being the technical secretariat of EVM Assessments, provided its support to the State in planning, providing national assessors, training and capacity building, data collection through mobile application and data collection from the field.



National Health Mission/RCH-II

During the reported quarter, three monitoring visits in two states (Maharashtra-2 and Tamil Nadu-1) were conducted to assess the quality of the ongoing SBA and Skill Lab trainings for various categories of health personnel in the state. RCH Consultants also assessed the training sites infrastructure, status of training data base, availability of trainers, post-training performance, proper selection of trainees and deployment of trained manpower. health facility visits were conducted in Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu. Feedback on training courses along with recommendations have been prepared and submitted to MoHFW with a copy to states on 27 visit reports received from consultants of SIHFW/CTIs for the states of Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, CINI-Kolkata, IHFW-Kolkata and Odisha to improve the quality of trainings. Quarterly Progress Report for the 2nd quarter (July- September 2018) was prepared after analyzing and compiling the monthly training progress report received from the states, and has been submitted to MoHFW.

Centre for Health Informatics (CHI) of National Health Portal (NHP)

Some of the significant activities of CHI in the reported quarter are listed below:

- Information related to new diseases like Traumatic Hyphaema, Airbag Eye Injury and Chalcosis have been added under the Diseases A-Z section.
- As per the selected themes, CHI added new contents of 3 Health Days viz. International Day of Older Persons, World Mental Health Day and World Food Day in the Health Wellness Calendar of NHP.
- As per the selected themes, CHI revised the contents of 15 Health Days viz. World Sight Day, International Day of Girl Child, World Obesity Day, World Arthritis Day, Global Hand Washing Day, World Iodine Deficiency Day, World Polio Day, World Stroke Day, World Antibiotic Awareness Day, World Diabetes Day, World Toilet Day, World COPD Day, World AIDS Day, National Pollution Day and International Day of Persons with Disabilities in the Health Wellness Calendar of NHP. - A two-page feature article in English highlighting the MoHFW's initiatives on different health issues such as Ayushman Bharat- Providing Affordable Healthcare, Mission Indradhanush-Universal Immunization Programme, Strengthening Primary Healthcare, and one full page advertorial each in Hindi and in English on NHP's initiatives were published during October-December 2018 in the monthly 'The DIALOGue', 'EXOTICA' and Airport India Magazines for dissemination of information.
- NHP has made a remarkable social media presence with twitter impression of approximately 29 lakhs and facebook posts have reached approximately 31 lakhs during this quarter. NHP team regularly updates the health tips and messages on social media.

Public Health Systems Capacity Building in India

With the objectives to strengthen surveillance activities, outbreak investigation and improve managerial skills of health work force working at the state and district levels; Public Health Systems Capacity Building in India project (PHSCBI) is established in NIHFWS on 20 November 2014 for a period of five years.

The project is focusing on data analysis; identifying and prioritizing health problems; designing evidence-based interventions; and investigating outbreaks and response. To achieve the goals planned under the Global Health Security Agenda (GHS), the project has planned the following training programmes:

- Frontline Epidemiology Training of 3-months duration for District Epidemiologists and Deputy CMHOs
- Rapid Response Team Training of Trainers (RRT-TOT) for States
- Public Health Management Training of Trainers (PHM- TOT) for States

Among other things, PHSCBI carried out the following activities during the last quarter:

1. Two advocacy meetings were held in the States of Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh for conducting the Frontline Epidemiology Training.
2. Karnataka agreed to conduct the 3-months duration Frontline Epidemiology Training from 28 January 2019 in Bengaluru.
3. Madhya Pradesh agreed to conduct the Frontline Epidemiology Training in Bhopal for which dates are being finalized.
4. For RRT –TOTs, the states have been finalized in coordination with National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC).
5. PHM modules are near completion for final review.
