ABOUT THE COURSE

The care of patients involves different health professionals who use communication as a primary tool for gathering information in order to diagnose, counsel, rehabilitate and build a therapeutic alliance with patients. Despite communication of being an important part of the health system management it is often seen neglected. There is an inevitable need to use effective communication approaches to support and strengthen the delivery of health care services. It is widely accepted that an effective communication approach in healthcare system would help to foster teamwork, boost confidence in decision making and improve working relationships. Keeping this in view a 5 days training course of "Communication in Health care management" will be conducted from 15-19 January. 2024.

GENERAL OBJECTIVE
