ABOUT THE COURSE

The NHM envisages the achievement of universal access to equitable, affordable & quality health care services in both rural and urban areas. One of the key strategies is to create a District Level Knowledge Centre within each District Hospital — a hub for secondary care, select tertiary care, skill-based training for all cadres of health workers, data analysis, and district planning.

Over the years, the expansion of health care services has made it obligatory for Chief Medical Officers, Deputy CMOs and Programme Officers at the district level to discharge comprehensive job responsibilities. Depending on the scale of the system, health care administration requires several teams working in unison at every level. Limited exposure to approaches of health care administration and management often makes it difficult for district-level officers to discharge these responsibilities smoothly.

Keeping this in view, this training course has been scheduled at NIHFV from November 16–20, 2026. The five-day course will enhance participants' administrative acumen across General Procedures & Guidelines, Human Resource Management, Financial Management, Materials Management and the management of ongoing health programmes and projects not covered during regular medical education.

GENERAL OBJECTIVE

To enhance the professional efficacy and administrative acumen of district-level health officials by providing knowledge and skills in Health System Management for strengthening district health care delivery services.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Enumerate the standard procedures and guidelines laid down under different health programs for efficient management of district health care delivery services.
- Delineate the implementation strategies, inputs and outputs of health care services.
- Describe the significant role of capacity building, leadership techniques and communication approaches for strengthening effective delivery of health care services.
- Describe the operational aspect of the Health and Wellness Centres.
